## What will Co-classes be like online?

The Math and Physics specialists in AATC will teach live sessions using Zoom. In these sessions, there will be a mixture of Specialists presenting the main topics from your lecture, opportunities for students to ask questions, and time with students in smaller breakout rooms to talk and work through problems together. Students in co-classes will also have access through Canvas to additional handouts, reminders, practice problems, video lessons, and most importantly: each other! AATC Specialists use discussion boards to help students connect with each other, and learn from peers.

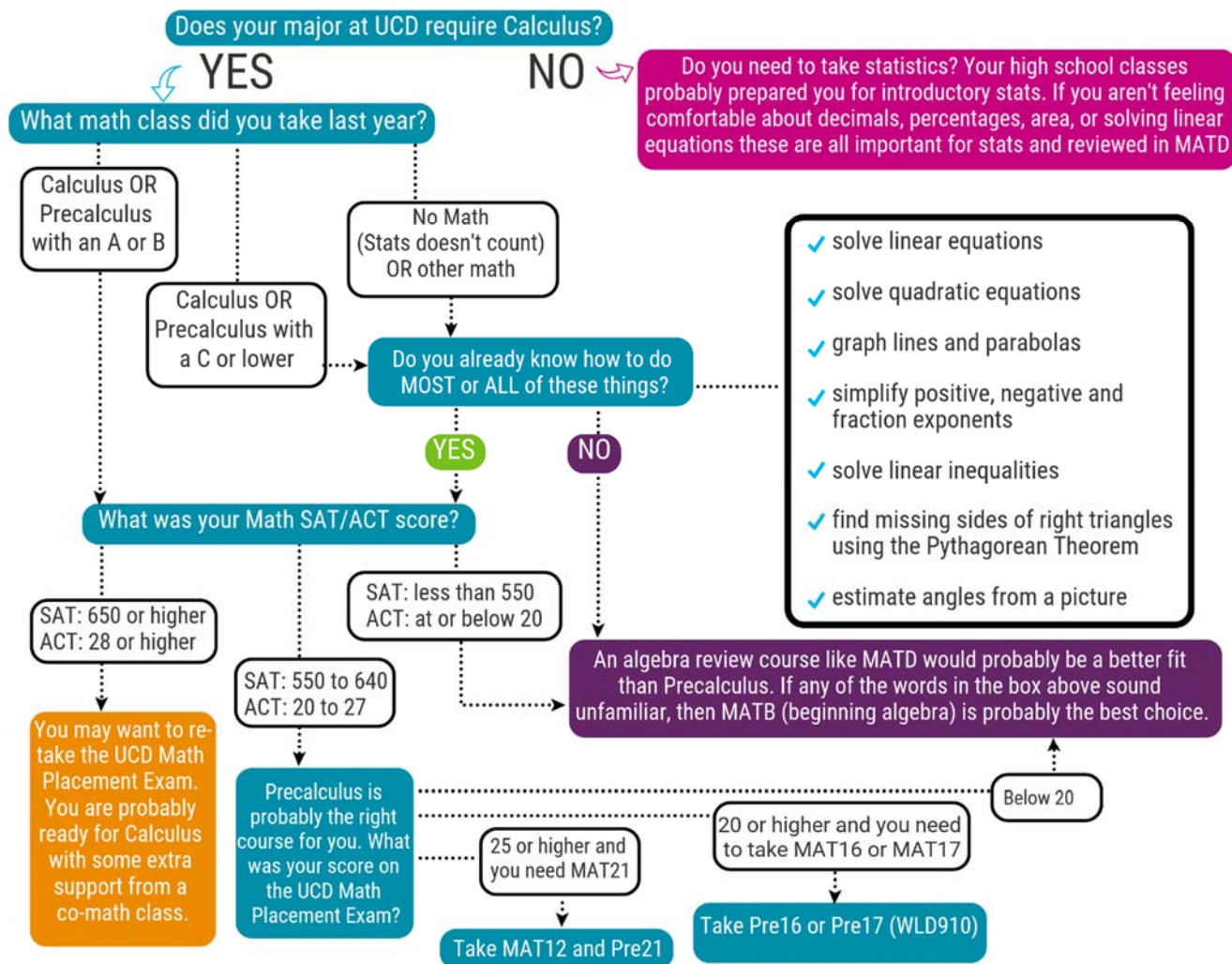
